1. Welcome by Mrs. Westerlind
2. Wellness Updates:  
Lunch/Nutrition will now offer three menu items. This will provide less sugar and healthier choices for our students. All bread products will be wheat and there will be more fruits and vegetables available.  
  
PE/Health Updates:  
We have hired a PE specialist with the school FTE funds. If we could have added an additional classroom teacher to help reduce class sizes we would have, but we do not have a classroom open to house another class. Ms. Briten is working with our students to learn and understand that making a healthy lifestyle choice is important. She will not only teach our PE core curriculum but will push into classrooms for nutrition and health lessons throughout the year. Members suggested teaching our students some morning stretches and then having all teachers provide time for it.
3. CSIP (Comprehensive School Improvement Plan)  
This year there is not district allocated funds for CSIP. We will still move forward with our goals and connect them to the Trust land funds in the future. The district is planning ways to support the schools and connect these to plan together.

Data and updates on the progress of Dragon Training/ Rtl (Response to Interventions) were shared. It is working and our students are showing progress. The curriculum aides are

working hard and helping to more students towards grade level benchmarks.

4. SNAP plan was reviewed. We are still waiting for word from Draper City on when the new sidewalk will be installed. The parking lot drop off/ pick up procedures were reviewed and it seems to work better to have parents access both the pick up /drop off lane and the bus lane. Once all seven buses have departed, we open up the bus lane to provider a quicker flow. It is working and parents are noticing.
5. Trust Land support is needed. We want to encourage everyone to write our legislators informing them to not use the Trust land money for any other purpose than the needs of public schools.
6. School Registration for the 2012-2013 school year will be online. The district is transitioning all schools to online registration. Please share this will your neighbors and community so that they can be aware of this change.
