### **Meeting called to order: 3:05.**

Meeting held in Collaboration Room due to Book Fair in the Library.

### **Meeting Agenda:**

1. Prior meeting minutes' approval Janene
  - a. Notes approved by Madison and seconded by Mike.
2. Safety Drill Update Christy
  - a. This month the school had a Shelter in Place drill. It went well. March will be a Fire drill and April will be an Earthquake drill.
3. Review School Data Emily
  - a. Emily reported incredible growth in ELA and Math this year so far.
  - b. ELA scores for the whole school has made 12.6% growth (65%-77.5%). The CSIP goal was 8%
  - c. Math scores for the whole school has made 15% growth (63%-78%). The CSIP goal was 6%.
  - d. Emily provided the following data for each grade:
    1. Kindergarten:
      1. First Sound Fluency 26% growth
      2. Quantity Discrimination 22% growth
    2. First Grade
      1. Nonsense Word Fluency 12% growth
      2. Math 11% growth
    3. Second Grade
      1. Reading 8% growth
      2. Math 23% growth
    4. Third Grade

1. Reading 7% growth
2. Math 14% growth
5. Fourth Grade
  1. Reading 15% growth
  2. Math 10% growth
6. Fifth Grade
  1. Reading 4% growth
  2. Math 11% growth
- e. Emily suggested reasons we may have seen so much growth
  1. She feels teacher satisfaction is high
  2. The school upgraded Tier 2 ELA (that was bought with Land Trust money last year)
  3. Dyad reading in each grade
  4. Close reading and integrating this into science
  5. Increased attention to progress monitoring in math using DIBELS
  6. Clearer instruction
  7. Accountability with progress monitoring
  8. Increased phonemic awareness reviewed and practiced school wide
  9. iReady is new this year and has helped kids become automatic with learned skills
  10. Kindergarten teachers are doing “Lunch Bunch” and providing intervention to students who need extra help during the lunch hour (after AM kindergarten and before PM kindergarten).
- f. We discussed the special education students and their progress and growth. It is reported that they have not been making the same gains. Christy suggested that it could be that IEP goals are not rigorous enough. We discussed that the special education team may need more training. Christy reported that they received an in-service at the beginning of the year. Christy and Emily stated that they are working with the special education team to determine what to do to help increase student growth.
4. Review Budget for 2018-2019 School Year Christy
  - a. Christy reports that we are on track for our budget this year.
5. Discuss CSIP and LAND Trust Plan Christy
  - a. The Building Leadership Team and SCC will take the data from Emily and come up with goals for next year. Due to our great progress this year, Christy suggested we increase our goals. Christy welcomes any suggestions or comments regarding ways to continue increased growth and goal ideas.

On Tuesday 2/19/19, a large group of parents represented Draper Elementary school at the school district meeting to discuss concerns regarding Draper’s parking lot. Christy reported that Leon (Canyon’s District CFO) called her and discussed a timeline to address and update the parking lot. The timeline starts 2/26/19 and ends December 2019. Christy stated that we have to give the land to the city where the road will continue through the parking lot. Christy will be meeting with engineers soon to discuss the parking lot. She is going to have a certain spot for each bus to park every day so students can easily find their bus. There will be more parking for visitors. Jen Morris recommended relocating the bike parking and adding grass and/or trees to help the revision look more “neighborhood-ish”.
