

Draper Elementary Safe Walking Route

Dear Parents/Guardians:

Please discuss these important guidelines with your children attending Draper Elementary School. After reviewing, please take time to walk the designated route with your child to help point out possible hazards. For the safety and well being of all students, families are to adhere to the following:

- The safest, most direct walking routes to Draper Elementary are marked on the following map with green arrows. Each family should decide which of these streets are easiest to get to and from the home.
- All students riding to school on a bike or scooter should understand the rules of the road and take caution. Students must walk bicycles and scooters once on school property and park at the bike rack. Students should wear bike helmets and follow bike safety procedures.
- Students should only cross streets where there is a designated crosswalk. Draper City crossing guards are stationed at 12660 S and Fort St. Students and adults should follow the directions given by safety personnel.
- Safety in the school parking lot is the responsibility of everyone. Students and adults should respect and obey crossing guards, school staff, and safety patrol members as they fulfill their duties.
- All students should go straight home from school. Do not accept rides without parent permission. Any strange or dangerous behavior should be reported to local authorities and the school.

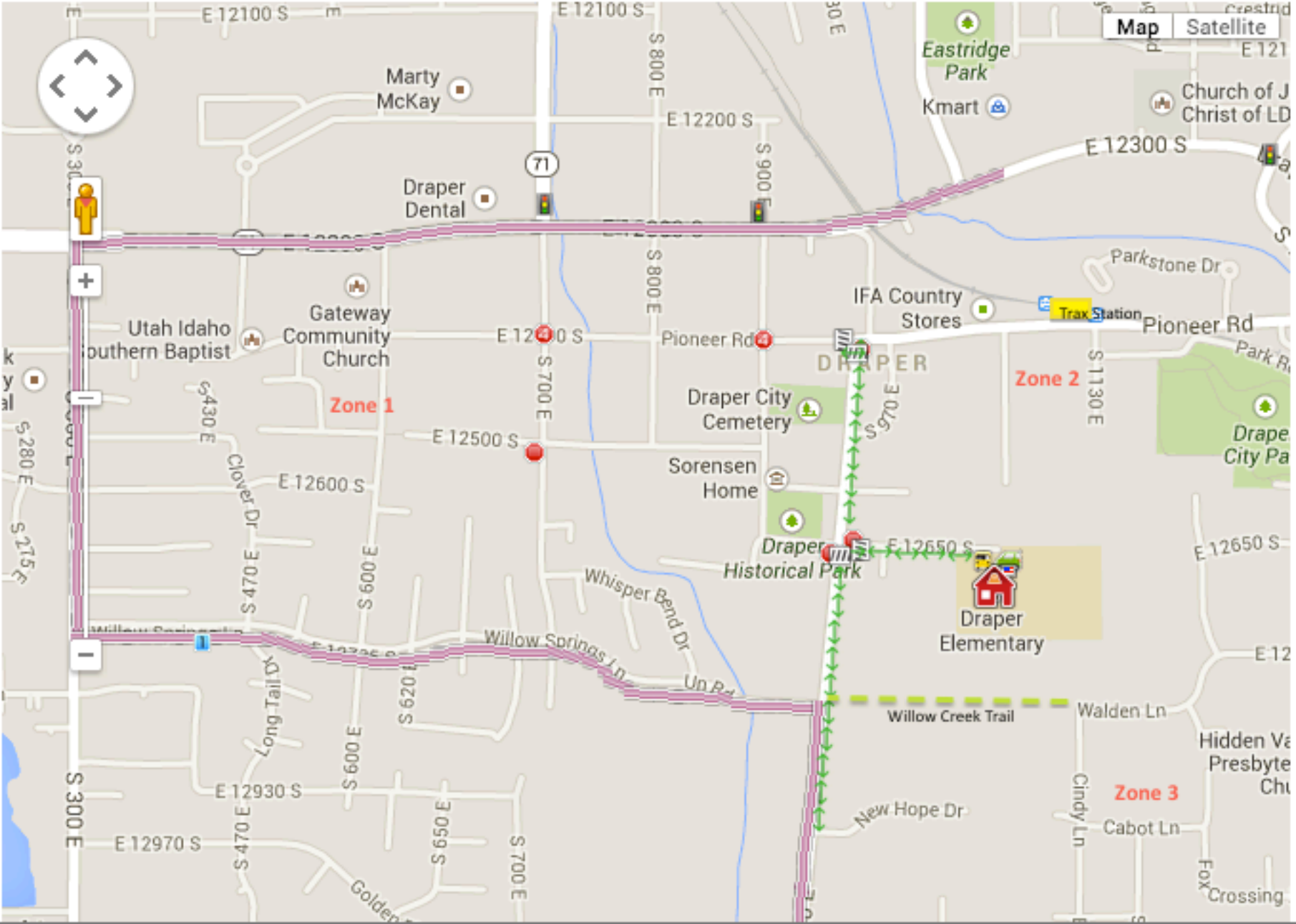
For students walking and/or riding a bike to school, please consider these safest routes:

Zone 1 (west of the school): Students who live south of 12300 S. and west of Fort St. will progress from neighborhood streets to 12300 S/Pioneer St. or Willow Springs Lane. Walking east they will continue until they reach Fort St. where they will cross with the crossing guard at Fort St. and 12650 S. to the school.

Zone 2 (northeast of the school): Students north of 12660 S. and east of Fort St. will walk to Fort St. via Pioneer Rd. or neighborhood streets and proceed south to enter school property at 12650 S.

Zone 3 (southeast of the school): Students south of 12660 S. and east of Fort St. will walk neighborhood streets to Fort St. and proceed north and enter the school property along 12650 S. Students may also access the Willow Creek trail to get to Fort St.
