Draper Elementary has been implementing the 2013-14 School Plan to improve the number of students in all grade level reaching benchmark in Math and ELA by 5% (when comparing Fall 2013 CBM data to Spring 2014 CBM data). School LAND Trust money has been spent to hire curriculum aides to support Reading and Math instruction (\$45,110.03). As of January 30, 2013, our grade levels have made the following increases thus far:
