2. Approve Previous Meeting Minutes Janene- approved via email
3. SCC Elections, Ballots, Open Seats for 2021-2022 Janene

4. COVID Update Christy

6. Safety Drills Christy  
Earthquake drill this Thursday as part of the Great Utah Shakeout. May will be an evacuation drill.
7. Budget Review Christy  
We're good on the budget since money was transferred from the amendment. Teachers are turning in timesheets for the teachers tutoring and Christy is keeping track to make sure we don't go over budget.  
The District will be holding a summer school and will provide busing. There might also be language for DLI offered.
8. Safe Walking Routes Stacey  
There was supposed to be a meeting with someone at the district and he forgot. He said we need to get a list of areas of concerns and where our buses go. Christy called Jeremy
