Safety Drill Update:

CSIP and Land Trust

- CSIP and LAND Trust are the same thing
 - Going to continue with Reading and Math
 - Measure from Fall to Spring
 - Reading Proficiency to increase by 10% for next year (increase from last year)
 - Math Proficient to increase by 10% (increase from last year)
 - Tier 1 – All Kids
 - Tier 2 – Intervention
 - Tier 3 – Special Education (35 kids)
 - Positive Behavior Intervention Support – an additional goal
 - Intervention for Reading Difficulties Program Grant
 - Provides additional money for training for teachers who work in tier 3 instructions
 - Total Spend: \$74,600
