**Meeting Agenda:**

1. Welcome/Introductions Janene
2. Elect Chair/Vice Chair/Secretary Janene
  - a. Secretary: Megan Litster
  - b. Vice Chair: Brooke Free
3. Review Bylaws Janene
  - a. VII b changed "Distribute meeting minutes with members for approval"
  - b. Add a new section for meeting minutes - approve via email or during SCC meeting
4. SCC training dates & times Christy
  - a. Training schedule shared with members
5. School Update Christy
  - a. 1 person in the school is positive with COVID
  - b. Quarantines are different this year
    - i. If we have 30 people test positive in the school within 2 weeks - then we go to "test to stay"
      1. Test negative - stay in school
      2. Test positive - stay home 10 days
      3. Don't test - stay home 10 days
    - ii. If Teacher is COVID positive, parents will be informed by the RN/skylert and can decide if they'd like to send their student to school
    - iii. Student Exposed to COVID - (from someone that was within 6 feet of the student)
      1. First Option: quarantine for 10 days
      2. Second Option: come to school with a mask for 10 days
      3. Third Option: come to school without a mask
  - c. Testing - school district, pediatrician, Walmart has an-over counter self-test
    - i. District Testing: Monday and Thursday mornings

- d. Some students are wearing masks in every grade. Some teachers are wearing masks at times during the day.
  - e. Teachers are doing rug-time this year. Not for very long. Students love this time.
  - f. Desks are not social-distanced like last year
  - g. Lunchroom - assigned table. Sitting closer together than they were last year
  - h. School continues to do precautions - cleaning
  - i. Hard to get substitutes. We need substitutes!!
  - j. State is requiring all K-12 grade teachers, because of low performance on testing, attend a LETRS training.
    - i. LETRS is an intensive professional learning program for teachers (Requires 1-2hrs a week outside of contract time). Federal government is funding this.
    - ii. It's mandatory for K-3 teachers
    - iii. All our Kindergarten and 1st grade teachers are going to an all day training on 10/22 (Chinese teachers not going)
    - iv. We need 8 substitutes on Friday 10/22
  - k. Teachers are feeling stressed and overwhelmed.
  - l. Christy would like to move \$1,000 to principal discretionary funds
  - m. Motion: Move \$1500 cell tower money to principal discretionary funds to support teachers. Motion approved.
  - n. Second Steps - social emotional curriculum
    - i. Elementary school curriculum is different than Middle School and High School curriculum
    - ii. Teachers here at Draper Elementary School like this curriculum
    - iii. Covers: Empathy, recognize when you are focused, feelings recognition, deep breathing, etc.

    - i. White Ribbon Week

- a. Stacey and Christy worked on things over the summer
