- 4. Digital Citizenship/School Safety

Ronnie

 - Stacey reported that the flyer sent home about what the kids were discussing about digital citizenship was very helpful for parents to know what was going
 - Nancy asked about Life Skills and Ronnie clarified that the district hasn't started their Life Skills curriculum. Ronnie let us know that the school is doing a Life Skills discussion monthly

with different topics. It will be listed on the Principal's News. This month the character is "Respect". August's character was "Friendship". Basic and simple life skills.

5. Safe Walking Routes

Stacev

- a. Stacey's students do not have a safe walking route coming to school. Stacey reached out to the city. She asked for a walking path and it never was put in. Stacey has tried to get a walking route behind the school - Ivory Homes and the man next to Ivory Homes. The district didn't think it was safe and wanted a locked gate.
- b. The SCC has put out a survey to parents regarding walking routes. We ended up with the following concerns:
 - East side of school Ivory Homes now have a crossing guard!
 - 4-way stop on Fort Street and 12600 s most dangerous crosswalk in the city
 - iii. No sidewalks on Fort Street where kids are walking to school
- c. The Moda Peak community houses 6+ kids that come to our school and they do not have a safe walking route to school
- d. Stacey has emailed city and we have not heard back
- e. Action Steps:
 - Stacey needs to be assured or directed on which way to go with pursuing a safer corner
 - ii. Are there other areas we need to be fighting for?
- 6. Kindergarten Playground & Recess

Janene

- a. We have 2 broken arms on the playground for Kindergarten
 - i. New Playground Equipment can be \$85,000+
 - ii. The district does a rotation for playground equipment takes about 10 years
 - iii. Safety concerns can the district can change the flooring? Ronnie will follow up with the district in regards to this.
