Call to Order

- Attendance: All members present except for Becky, Deanna, and Arlene.
- Approval of Minutes: Kaydee noted a typo in the previous minutes: the December minutes (not January) were approved at the last meeting. Alivia motioned to approve the updated January minutes; Brian seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

TSSP and LandTrust Plans

- Data Review: The Council reviewed mid-year Acadience data. While some SCC goals were met, improvement goals for students performing above grade level were not achieved. It was suggested to use "Pathways" as an action item rather than a specific goal.

- Math Intervention: The Tier 2 Math Aide (SCC-funded) is showing positive results with older grades, evidenced by improved math scores.
- Mondays with Marissa: Surveys indicate a 98% rate of knowledge and application among participants.

Principal News

- Safety & Traffic: A District safety officer assessed the drop-off/pick-up system and will consult with the Director of Facilities.
- Security: Exterior doors can no longer be propped open and will now be programmed to alarm if left open for a set duration (time TBD).
- City Infrastructure: Alivia reported from a recent town hall that the Fort Street project has been delayed until 2027.

STEAM Night (March 31st)

- Activities: The district STEAM kit is reserved; Kit 2 includes new activities. The SCC will select 2–3 activities at the next meeting based on volunteer availability. Kaibots, Spheros, and clay activities will return.
- Incentives: Students visiting every station will receive a drawing ticket for STEAM kits to be awarded the following day.
- Volunteers: Additional volunteers are needed for the event.
- Marketing: Outreach will include ParentSquare, Principal News, and morning announcements.
