TSSP and LandTrust Plans

- No new information or amendments needed at this time

Principal News

- Permit and Registration Deadlines:
 - Kindergarten Registration: Opens this Wednesday.
 - Variance Permits: The school will begin accepting variance permits for the 2026–2027 school year this Friday.
- Enrollment and Staffing:
 - Current Numbers: Student enrollment is currently between 675 and 678, which is approximately 15 students lower than last year.
 - Kindergarten Data: There are currently about 103 kindergarten students.
 - Staffing Impact: Due to declining numbers, the school is at risk of losing one teacher. The first draft of the Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) staffing report is expected by the end of this month.
 - New Development: To date, only five students have registered from the new residential development across the street.
- Parking Lot Proposal:
 - The Principal is currently developing a response and proposal to address ongoing parking lot issues.
 - Action Item: Once the proposal is finalized, it will be sent to the SCC for formal review.
